President Hage G. Geingob holds meeting with senior officials in The Presidency, emphasizes effectiveness, courteous service and discipline

President Hage G. Geingob met with senior officials in The Presidency today, 11 May 2020 to remind them about the need to be exemplary servants of the Namibian people. President Geingob emphasized to the senior officials that the ethos of The Presidency should be courtesy, transparency, effectiveness and a commitment to excellence in the provision of services to the public. The President said that there are clear standards of service that individuals and the public should reasonably expect from The Presidency and Government at large. Services must be provided without discrimination, favoritism, tribalism or racism. Racism and tribalism are the same thing and have no place in governance, the President said.

President Geingob cautioned the senior officials that they have to do more with less, be prudent and save taxpayers resources at all times.

President Geingob concluded by saying that senior officials are expected to provide leadership, teamwork, harmonious working relations and must be disciplined at all times. *“We all need one another to make Namibia a better place for all”*, the President said.
