President Hage G. Geingob receives at State House, Mr. Mohamed Salem Ouldsalek, Foreign Minister of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic

The Foreign Minister of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic, Mr. Mohamed Salem Ouldsalek paid a courtesy visit on President Hage G. Geingob on 14 May 2018. The purpose of the visit was to brief President Geingob on developments around the question of self-determination for the Sahrawi people.

The President and the Foreign Minister commended the work of Mr. Horst Köhler, UN Special Envoy on Western Sahara. President Geingob called on the African Union, the United Nations Security Council and the International Community to respect AU positions, and ensure implementation of Security Council Resolutions on Western Sahara.

President Geingob expressed appreciation for the visit, and reiterated Namibia's principled stance and solidarity with the Polisario and the people of Western Sahara in their struggle for self-determination.
